A Word in season: speak softly and carry a big stick... Do you sometimes find yourself "defending" God and His purpose?

Wisdom: a soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. We do not have to defend God's kingdom, nor do we have to compromise our convictions. We need only to speak the truth of any situation with humility, and the power of God's Spirit will amplify the truth in power. Don't allow disagreement to become a shouting match; with one or both of you walking away in anger. Trust Him to bring you through every conflict in victory.

What is a word in season? It's simply a word from God that comes just when you need it. The word of God is living and powerful and when it comes, it removes bondages and brings forth truth. It shines the light of God on the situation and when the light of the word of God shines, darkness and deception have to go.
